The demand regulator has been certified by Germanischer Lloyd AG according to EC Directive 89/686/EEC based on the EN 250 with EC Type Examination Certificate No. 50 390 - 05 HH dated. 2005-11-02. Additional tests have been carried out for a diving depth down to 200 m under consideration of the requirements of Para 5.2.2 of the Norsok Standard U-101 'Diving Respiratory Equipment' Rev. 1, August 1999 with a RMV of 62.5 l/min in swimming position.

#### Results of Examination:

The above mentioned demand regulator fulfills for use with Heliox the requirements of the EN 250:2000 regarding WOB taking into consideration the limit values of the Norsok Standard 5.2.2 line 1 for a diving depth >180 msw.
